## RESOLUTION NO. /O/

A Resolution requesting that a portion of the City of Columbus be designated as an enterprise zone authorized by K.S.A. 12-17, 109; 12-17, 110; 12-17, 112; 79-32, 153; and 79-3641.

WHEREAS, The areas, described on the Enterprise Zone Boundary Map, are wholly within the corporate limits of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, The areas include vacant and underutilized land and buildings; and

WHEREAS, The areas have a population not exceeding 25% of the population of the City and a land area not exceeding 25% of the land area of the City; and

WHEREAS, The zone is located within a City which meets the requirements for federal assistance under Section 119 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended; and

WHEREAS, The City is prepared to provide a local incentive as described in the Enterprise Zone Plan; and

WHEREAS, The City Council has considered the eligibility requirements and certifies the correctness of supporting evidence; and

WHEREAS, The legal counsel for the City has provided a written opinion of conformance to the law for designation as an Enterprise Zone: NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Columbus:
That the area meets the requirements for designation as an Enterprise Zone; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Secretary of the Department of Economic Development is hereby requested to approve these areas as an authorized Enterprise Zone consistent with K.S.A. 12-17,109 et seq.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That Resolution Number 78 be rescinded upon approval of the application accompanying this resolution by the Kansas Department of Economic Development.
