March 3, 2014 6:30 P.M.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

The City Council of Columbus, Kansas, met March 3, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. in the City Hall, presided over by Mayor Grant Spieth. Council members present: Dale Burton, Jerri Burton, Barbara Capron, Doug Hosier, Mike Leighty, Marion Morgan, Thomas Niegisch (6:33), Dewey Smith (6:40), Gary Smith. Council member absent: None.

Mike Leighty led the Invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

### **COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

Burton Jerri moved to approve the Council Meeting minutes from February 18, 2014 as written. Hosier seconded the motion. Voting aye: Burton Dale, Burton Jerri, Capron, Hosier, Leighty, Morgan. Voting nay: None. Abstain: Niegisch, Smith Gary. Motion carried 6-0-2.

### **APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 13-347**

Leighty moved to approve Appropriation Ordinance number 13-347 as presented. Capron seconded the motion. Voting aye: Burton Dale, Burton Jerri, Capron, Hosier, Leighty, Morgan, Niegisch, Smith Gary. Voting nay: None. Motion carried 8-0.

### **APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE 14-348**

### VISITOR - BILL HIRSCHLER

Bill Hirschler, ING representative, addressed the council with information regarding a retirement plan option for city employees that could be utilized in addition to the current KPERS retirement package. No action was taken at this time.

# **VISITOR - BRUCE REMSBERG**

Bruce Remsberg, Professional Engineering Consultant representative, addressed the council regarding bids received on the Sanitary Sewer Lagoon Improvement – Part A Sludge Removal Project and Part B Flow Monitoring Project.

Remsberg stated each bid for Part A included the base and add/alternate pricing. The base bid covered sludge removal, while the add/alternate portion included 10" pipe replacement within the lagoon.

Remsberg informed the council that a single bid was received on Part B Flow Monitoring Project, this bid exceeded the expected project cost and PEC recommended the council reject this bid.
