**ORDINANCE NO. 1201**

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REVISING CITY CODE SECTION 15-437, AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1196, TO AUTHORIZE THE MONTHLY TRANSFER OF SEWER DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE FEES AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.**

**SECTION 1: Section 15-437. ADMINISTRATIVE FEES. Administrative Fees in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) shall transfer each month to Administrative Assessments in the General Fund, effective January 1, 2006.**

SECTION 2: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
