ORDINANCE NO. 1212

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, TO PROVIDE FOR THE LAWFUL OPERATION OF WORK-SITE UTILITY VEHICLES AND ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES BY CITY OFFICIALS AND AUTHORIZED CITY EMPLOYEES ON CITY STREETS AND ON CITY PROPERTY IN THE NORMAL COURSE OF CITY BUSINESS AND FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The City of Columbus hereby provides for the lawful operation of work-site utility vehicles and all-terrain vehicles by City officials and authorized City employees on City streets and on City property in the normal course of City business and for emergency response.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
