ORDINANCE NO. 1221

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS,
KANSAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1215 - REGULATIONS
PERTAINING TO ELECTRIC PERSONAL ASSISTIVE MOBILITY DEVICES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS,
KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance Number 1215 shall be repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from
and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
