**ORDINANCE NO. 1222**

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1218 IN ORDER TO CORRECT THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF CERTAIN LAND BEING ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF COLUMBUS IN CONFORMITY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 12-520, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: The following corrected legal description of real estate, located on East Merle Evans Drive, Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, to-wit:

A portion of Lot 3, being a portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Eighteen (18), Township Thirty-three (33) South, Range Twenty-four (24) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Cherokee County, Kansas, more particularly, described as follows:

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Eighteen (18), Township Thirty-three (33) South, Range Twenty-four (24) East of the Sixth Principal Meridian; thence with an assumed bearing of North 89 degrees 56 minutes 50 seconds East along the South line of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4) 692.18 feet (previously described as 692.6 feet) for the point of beginning; thence North 00 degree 27 minutes 10 seconds West 398.00 feet; thence North 89 degrees 56 minutes 50 seconds East parallel with the South line of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4) 260.00 feet; thence South 00 degree 27 minutes 10 seconds East 398.00 feet to the South line of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4); thence South 89 degrees 56 minutes 50 seconds West along the South line of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of said Southwest Quarter (SW/4) 260.00 feet to the point of beginning containing 2.376 Acres subject to any easements of record.

meeting one or more of the classifications for annexation prescribed by K.S.A. 12-520, is hereby annexed and made a part of the City of Columbus, Kansas.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall amend Ordinance Number 1218 and take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication in the official City newspaper.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
