ORDINANCE NO. 1223

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1193, AND CITY CODE SECTION 15-406A, INCREASING RATES AND FEES CHARGED EACH CUSTOMER AND USER FOR SEWER SERVICE FROM THE SEWER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That beginning with the meter readings on or after the 1st day of October, 2007, the rates to be charged for sewer service furnished by the sewer system of the City of Columbus, Kansas for each meter for residences within the city limits shall be as follows:

Section 15-406A. SEWER CHARGES. (a) Beginning with the meter readings on the 1st day of **October, 2007**, the rates to be charged for sewer service furnished by the sewer system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, for each meter for residences within the City limits shall be as follows:

- (1) A minimum charge of **\$8.50 per month on 2000 gallons per household** shall be made for each user within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas.
- (2) For water usage, the charge shall be **\$2.25** per each thousand gallons used over **2000** gallons.

(b) This ordinance shall not include the Carolina Turkey Plant outside of the corporate city limits.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
