ORDINANCE NO. 1241

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1160, SECTION XII OF THE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, ESTABLISHING POLICIES TO REGULATE CELL PHONE USE BY EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

Section 1: That Ordinance 1160 and Section XII of the Personnel Regulations for the Employees of the City of Columbus, Kansas, is hereby amended.

Section 2: That the following shall be new Section XII-13.

NEW SECTION XII-13 Personal Cell Phones and Communication Devices.

To better insure the safety of employees and the efficient operation of City departments the following policies are established:

- A. The use of personal cell phones and other communications devices by employees is strictly prohibited while employees are on the job or on duty for the City.**
- B. The use of City cell phones for personal calls, incoming or outgoing, by employees, is strictly prohibited at all times while employees are on the job, on duty for the City, or off duty.**

Section 3: All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
