ORDINANCE NO. 1256

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING CHAPTER XV OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REQUIRING THAT PRIVATE SEWER LINE CLEAN OUTS BE INSTALLED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY AND PROHIBITING INSTALLATION OF PRIVATE SEWER LINE CLEAN OUTS ON CITY EASEMENTS OR CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY AREAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: New City Code Section 15-409(8). The following regulation shall control future placement and installation of private sewer line clean outs.

- (a) All private sewer line clean outs shall be located and installed on private property.
- (b) Location or installation of private sewer line clean outs is prohibited on City easements or City right-of-way areas.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
