ORDINANCE NO. 1263

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHAPTER XIII: SECTION 13-206, AND ORDINANCE NUMBER 1254, SECTION 2, ADJUSTING STREET EXCAVATION FEES.

WHEREAS, the costs of materials and labor for resurfacing excavated areas of streets and alleys in the City of Columbus have changed.

WHEREAS, fees charged for resurfacing shall be adjusted to amounts consistent with current costs.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: Section 13-206 shall be amended as follows:

EXCAVATION FEES. A fee shall be charged by the City Clerk for excavation construction work affecting City streets and alleys. The excavation fee shall be in addition to all other fees for permits or charges relative to any proposed construction work. The excavation fee shall be determined based on the type of surface to be opened, dug or excavated under the permit issued and paid promptly after completion of the excavation and construction work, as follows:

- (a) A minimum fee of \$350 shall be charged to resurface an excavated area up to 36 square feet.
- (b) Excavation areas larger than 36 square feet shall be charged as follows:
 - a. On streets paved with asphalt - \$4.00 per square foot
 - b. On streets paved with asphalt, concrete and bitulithic on broken rock - \$4.00 per square foot.
 - c. In streets, alleys or rights-of-way AB-3 or pile run chat - \$2.00 per square foot.

SECTION 2: All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
