ORDINANCE NO. 1286

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF NORTH DIAMOND STREET
AND RETAINING ANY UTILITY EASEMENTS THEREON AND THEREIN.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:**


SECTION 1: That portion of North Diamond Street described as Lot Number Two (2) in Block Number Two (2) in the Third Addition to the City of Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, according to the recorded plat thereof, bounded and described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East line of said Lot Two (2), said point being a distance of Two hundred thirty seven (237) feet North of the Southeast Corner of said Lot Two (2); thence West and parallel with the South line of said Lot Two (2) a distance of One hundred twenty (120) feet; thence North and parallel with said East line a distance of One hundred seventy two and fifteen hundredths (172.15) feet, more or less to the North line of said Lot Two (2); thence Southeasterly along said North line a distance of One hundred twenty three and forty one hundredths (123.41) feet, more or less, to the Northeast Corner of said Lot Two (2); thence South along said East line a distance of One hundred forty three and eighty eight hundredths (143.88) feet, more or less, to the point of beginning is hereby vacated in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 14-423.

SECTION 2: The City of Columbus retains utility easements over, under, or along said vacated street.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after first publication in the official city newspaper unless a written protest is filed in the office of the City Clerk.
