ORDINANCE NO. 1387

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 182.1(e) OF THE 2010 EDITION OF THE STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AND REPEALING THE EXISTING SECTION 182.1(e), ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:**

SECTION 1. That Section 182.1(e) of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2010 approved by the City in Ordinance No. 1283 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That Section 182.1(e) is hereby amended as follows:

Section 182.1(e):

- (1) Prior to July 1, 2011, persons violating subsection (a) shall be fined \$50.00, plus court costs;
- (2) From and after July 1, 2011, persons violating subsection (a) shall be fined \$50.00 or the established minimum fine by ordinance, whichever is greater, plus court costs; and
- (3) Persons violating subsection (b) shall be fined \$50.00 or the established minimum fine, whichever is greater, plus court costs.

SECTION 3: All ordinances, resolutions or City policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are expressly repealed and insofar as they conflict herewith.


SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
