

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1301

A CHARTER ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 3 AND SECTION 5 OF CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 1250, PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:**

SECTION 1: That Section 3 and Section 5 of Ordinance 1250 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The new Section 3 of Ordinance 1250 shall read as follows:

SECTION 3. Vacancies for City employment except members of the Fire Department, Municipal Judge, City Attorney and members of boards, commissions, advisory groups and other bodies deemed necessary, shall be filled in accordance with established Personnel Policies and Guidelines. The Personnel Committee of the City Council shall recruit and interview applicants and recommend hiring of a candidate to the Governing Body for confirmation.

SECTION 3. The new Section 5 of Ordinance 1250 shall read as follows:

SECTION 5. The Mayor shall appoint, by and with the consent of the City Council, a Municipal Judge, members of the Fire Department, the City Attorney and members of boards, commissions, advisory groups or other bodies deemed necessary.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 5. CONFLICT. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty-one days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance, as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision C (3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case, the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.
