

ORDINANCE NO. 1305

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES AND FEES CHARGED EACH CUSTOMER AND USER FOR THE WASTEWATER SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION I. That beginning with the meter readings on or after the 1st day of January, 2012, the rates to be charged for wastewater disposal furnished by the wastewater system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, shall be as follows:

- a. A minimum charge of \$10.09 shall be made for each water meter within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and this charge includes 2,000 gallons of wastewater.
- b. For wastewater over 2,000 gallons, the charge shall be \$2.67 per thousand gallons.

SECTION II. That beginning with the meter readings on or after the 1st day of January, 2013, the rates to be charged for wastewater disposal furnished by the wastewater system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, shall be as follows:

- a. A minimum charge of \$10.70 shall be made for each water meter within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and this charge includes 2,000 gallons of wastewater.
- b. For wastewater over 2,000 gallons, the charge shall be \$2.83 per thousand gallons.

SECTION III. That beginning with the meter readings on or after the 1st day of January, 2014, the rates to be charged for wastewater disposal furnished by the wastewater system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, shall be as follows:

- a. A minimum charge of \$11.35 shall be made for each water meter within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and this charge includes 2,000 gallons of wastewater.
- b. For wastewater over 2,000 gallons, the charge shall be \$3.00 per thousand gallons.


SECTION IV. All ordinances and resolution and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.
