

ORDINANCE NO. 1322

An Ordinance regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas; incorporating by reference the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2013; providing certain penalties and repealing Ordinance No. 1310

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF
THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS;**

SECTION 1: INCORPORATING STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, that certain standard traffic ordinance known as the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities," Edition of 2013 prepared and published in book form by League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. No fewer than three copies of said Standard Traffic Ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. _____," and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Judge and all administrative departments of the city charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of such Standard Traffic Ordinance similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.

SECTION 2: TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS AND TRAFFIC OFFENSES.

(a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribed or required the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.


(b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

SECTION 3: PENALTY FOR SCHEDULED FINES. The fine for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or any other traffic offense for which the Municipal Judge establishes a fine in a fine schedule shall not be less than \$50.00 nor more than \$2,500.00, excluding seat belt violation. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction or other traffic offense for which a fine has been established in a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$2,500.00.

SECTION 4: REPEAL. Ordinance numbered 1310 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

ORDINANCE NO. 1323

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES AND FEES CHARGED EACH CUSTOMER AND USER FOR WATER SERVICE FROM THE WATER WORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION I. That beginning with the billing statements on or after the 1st day of February 2014, the rates to be charged for water service furnished by the water works system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, for each meter, for residences “within the city limits” shall be as follows:

- a. A minimum charge of **\$24.75** shall be made for each water meter within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and this charge includes 1,000 gallons of water.
- b. For water usage, the charge shall be **\$7.09** per thousand of gallons used over 1,000 gallons.
- c. The minimum charge and water usage charge shall each increase 3% annually beginning on January 1, 2015, and every January 1 thereafter.

SECTION II. That beginning with the billing statements on or after the 1st day of February 2014, the rates to be charged for water service furnished by the water works system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, for each meter, for residences “outside the city limits” shall be as follows:

- a. A minimum charge of **\$38.75** shall be made for each water meter outside the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and this charge includes 1,000 gallons of water.
- b. For water usage, the charge shall be **\$10.64** per thousand of gallons used over 1,000 gallons.
- c. The minimum charge and water usage charge shall each increase 3% annually beginning on January 1, 2015, and every January 1 thereafter.

SECTION III. That beginning with the billing statements on or after the 1st day of February 2014, the rates to be charged for water service furnished by the water works system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, through fire hydrants/plugs shall be as follows:

- a. The charge shall be **\$7.09** per thousand of gallons.
- b. The water usage charge shall increase 3% annually beginning on January 1, 2015, and every January 1 thereafter.

SECTION IV. That beginning with the billing statements on or after the 1st day of February 2014, rate to be charged for water service furnished by the water works system of the City of Columbus, Kansas, for consumers in modular, mobile or home trailer parks or apartment

houses or apartment complexes situated within the city limits of Columbus, Kansas, shall be as follows:

- a. A minimum charge of **\$82.50** shall be made for each water meter within the corporate limits of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and this charge does not include any water used.
- b. For water usage, the charge shall be **\$7.09** per thousand of gallons used.
- c. The minimum charge and water usage charge shall each increase 3% annually beginning on January 1, 2015, and every January 1 thereafter.

SECTION V. All ordinances and resolution and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

SECTION VI. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication in the Official City Newspaper.
