

**ORDINANCE NO. \_1341\_**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 206 OF ORDINANCE 1337 AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF  
THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That Chapter 2, Article 2, Section 206 of Ordinance 1337 is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 2.** The new Chapter 2, Article 2, Section 206 of Ordinance 1337 shall read as follows:

2-206. RUNNING AT LARGE; FINE. (a) It shall be unlawful for the owner or the harbored of any dog or cat to permit such dog or cat to run at large within the city at any time;

(b) Any dog or cat running at large within the city shall be impounded as set out in section 2-207;

(c) The owner of any dog or cat impounded for running at large without the tag required by section 2-202, shall for the first offense pay a fine of \$75.00, plus the boarding bill;

(d) For the first offense of an animal running at large with a tag as required by section 2-202, the owner or the harbored claiming any animal, shall in addition to presenting a registration receipt pay a fine of \$75.00, plus the cost of the boarding bill. For a second offense within a one-year period, the owner or harbored shall pay a fine of \$250.00, plus the boarding bill. For a third and all subsequent offenses within a one-year period, the owner or harbored shall pay a fine of \$500.00, plus the cost of the boarding bill;

(e) Dogs, cats, livestock and any other animal(s) are prohibited in City Parks. This prohibition does not apply to ADA approved service animals. Exceptions for special events may be granted by a vote of the governing body; and

(f) Any person violating or permitting the violation of section (e) of this section shall upon conviction in municipal court be fined a sum of not less than \$75.00 and not more than \$500.00. In addition to the fine imposed, the court may sentence the defendant to imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed 30 days. Further, the court shall order the payment of any impoundment fees, city licensing fees and/or vaccination fees.


**SECTION 3.** All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
