ORDINANCE NO. 1349

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REPEALING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 2, SECTIONS 2-201 THROUGH 2-204, REPEALING THE PROVISIONS FOR AN AUXILIARY POLICE FORCE, AND ESTABLISHING NEW CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 2, TO ESTABLISH AUTHORITY FOR THE RESERVE POLICE FORCE FOR THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, Code 1987, 18-32; Code 1987, 18-33; Code 1987, 18-35; and Ordinance 702, Section 1; Code 1999, codified in the Columbus City Code of Ordinances and adopted by the City Council at Chapter X, Article 2, Sections 201 through 204, established the Auxiliary Police Force.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That Code 1987, 18-32; Code 1987, 18-33; Code 1987, 18-35; and Ordinance 702, Section 1; Code 1999; Chapter X, Article 2, Sections 201 through 204, shall be repealed

SECTION 2: New Chapter X, Article 2, shall establish the authority for the city Reserve Police Force as follows:

10-201. ESTABLISHED; COMPOSITION.

A reserve police force of not more than ten (10) persons are hereby established for the city.

10-202. APPOINTMENT AND TERMS.

The members of the reserve police force shall be hired pursuant to the Personnel Regulations for the Employees of the City of Columbus, Kansas, from recommendations of the chief of police.


10-203. SUPERVISION.

The reserve police force shall be under the general supervision of the chief of police.

SECTION 3: All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
