ORDINANCE NO. 1351

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHAPTER I, SECTION 1-902, TO REVISE THE MAXIMUM EXPENDITURES AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY SUPERINTENDENT WITHOUT PRIOR COUNCIL APPROVAL.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1220, Code 2014, Columbus City Code of Ordinances, Chapter I, Section 902, as adopted by the City Council, established expenditure limits for department heads.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That Ordinance 1220, Code 2014, codified at Chapter I, Section 1-902 of the Columbus City Code of Ordinances, shall be amended as follows:

1-902. EXPENDITURES; DEPARTMENT HEADS.

**(a) The City Superintendent shall have the authority to make expenditures in accordance with city procedures of any moneys up to \$7,000. maximum without prior council approval.**

**(b) All other department heads shall have the authority to make expenditures in accordance with city procedures of any moneys up to \$2,000. maximum without prior council approval.**

SECTION 2: All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
