ORDINANCE NO. 1354

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING ARTICLE VI, 'SELECTION', SECTION VI-3, 'OPEN COMPETITIVE SELECTION', OF THE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

Section 1: Article VI, entitled 'Selection', section VI-3, 'Open competitive selection', of The Personnel Regulations For The City Of Columbus, Kansas, shall be amended to broaden the policy for open competitive selection when the City seeks to fill position vacancies by posting vacancies both internally and advertising externally.

Revised Article VI-3.


VI-3 Open competitive selection

All position vacancies sought to be filled by the City shall be concurrently posted internally and advertised externally. Job vacancies not filled by promotion or reassignment shall be open to all City employees in the classified service who meet the prescribed minimum qualifications for the position.

Section 2: REPEAL. All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
