

ORDINANCE NO. 1367

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ARTICLE XI, SECTION 1(E) OF THE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS REPEALING ANY ORDINANCE OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS;

SECTION 2. The following shall be the new Article XI, Section 1(E) of the Personnel Regulations for the Employees of the City of Columbus, Kansas:


**ARTICLE XI
SEPARATIONS**

XI-1 E. Employees who terminate employment voluntarily, which is accepted or approved by the Governing Body as not in good standing, may be precluded from consideration for future employment with the city and are precluded from accepting or continuing in any position, volunteer, reserve or other position, which may compensate the individual for their time.


SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
