ORDINANCE NO. 1369

AN ORDINANCE BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING CODE 1999 AND ORDINANCE 1118, SEC. 1, OF THE CODE FOR THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHAPTER V, SECTION 5-102, TO DEFINE BUSINESSES ELIGIBLE TO OBTAIN A GENERAL BUSINESS LICENSE.

WHEREAS, Code 1999, and Ordinance 1118, Sec. 1, Columbus City Code of Ordinances, Chapter V, Section 5-102, as adopted by the City Council, established the license fee for persons, firms or corporations desiring to do business in the City.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That Code 1999, and Ordinance 1118, Sec. 1, codified at Chapter V, Section 5-102 of the Code of the City of Columbus, Kansas, shall be amended as follows:

5-102 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. Every individual person, firm or corporation desiring to do business in the City, who is recognizable by reputation, name, credentials or otherwise, and in the discretion of the City Administrator or the City Clerk, shall apply to the City Clerk to operate such business at an annual fee of \$25.00. In the event the City Administrator or the City Clerk are unable to issue a business license from the information presented by the applicant, the application may be subject to an investigation pursuant to Section 5-105, or brought before the Columbus Police Committee for further consideration.

SECTION 2: Chapter V, Section 5-102a shall read as follows:

5-102a ROOFING CONTRACTORS. Every "roofing contractor" desiring to provide commercial or residential roofing services for a fee within the City of Columbus must provide a roofing contractor registration certificate from the Kansas Attorney General in order to qualify for a business license.

SECTION 3: All ordinances, resolutions or policies or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication in the official city newspaper.
