ORDINANCE NO. 1376

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REPEALING CITY CODE SECTION 15-221, CODE 1999, AND CITY CODE SECTION 15-435A(g), CODE 2014, AND ESTABLISHING A CONSOLIDATED PENALTY RATE PROVISION APPLICABLE TO LATE PAYMENTS FOR ALL CITY UTILITY BILLING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That City Code Section 15-221, Code 1999, and City Code Section 15-435A(g), Code 2014, shall be repealed for the establishment of an Ordinance consolidating the penalty rate applicable to late payments for all City utility billing.

SECTION 2:

New Section 15-108. Penalty. All payments for the previous month's City utility services shall be paid on or before the 10th day of the month following the service, except when the 10th day of the month falls on Saturday, Sunday or a legal holiday; then payment is due on the next business day. For billing not paid when due, a service charge of ten percent (10%) of the total amount due will be added to the bill.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.


SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
