ORDINANCE NO. 1389

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, VACATING THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY, LOCATED IN LASH'S 1ST ADDITION, SOUTH OF ELM STREET, BORDERING ON THE WEST IN BLOCK 4, LOTS 6, 7, 8, 9, AND 10, AND BORDERING ON THE WEST IN BLOCK 5, LOTS 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 AND 12; BORDERING ON THE EAST IN BLOCK 4, LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, AND 5 AND BORDERING ON THE EAST IN BLOCK 5, LOTS 6, 7, 8, 9, AND 10, SUBJECT TO UTILITY EASEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

Section 1: That the North-South Alley, Located In Lash's 1st addition, South Of Elm Street, Bordering On The West In Block 4, Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, And 10, And Bordering On The West In Block 5, Lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 And 12; Bordering On The East In Block 4, Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, And 5 And Bordering On The East In Block 5, Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, And 10, SHALL BE VACATED, SUBJECT TO UTILITY EASEMENTS.

Section 2: That the aforementioned alley shall revert to the owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to the frontage of such real estate except in cases where said alley was taken and appropriated to public use in a different proportion, in which case it shall revert to adjacent lots of real estate in proportion as it was taken from them.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official city newspaper.

Section 4. Immediately after this Ordinance becomes effective, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the County Clerk and in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Cherokee County, Kansas, to be entered in the transfer records and in the deed records, respectively, of Cherokee County, Kansas.
