ORDINANCE NO. 1396

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING CITY CODE, CHAPTER XV, SECTION 15-212, INCREASING THE CUSTOMER CHARGE FOR TESTING WATER METERS SERVICED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That City Code Chapter XV, Section 15-212, Code 1999, shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 2:

New Section 15-212: SAME; TESTING. Meters shall be tested before being set and at any other time thereafter when they appear to be measuring incorrectly. If a test is requested by the customer and the meter is found to be accurate within two percent, the meter will be deemed correct and a charge of **\$20.00** will be made to the customer.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall be in full force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
