ORDINANCE NO. 1413

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAGE FOR WEST BOUND TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF SW 20TH STREET AND CROSSLAND LANE IN COLUMBUS, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Due to increased traffic and safety concerns at the intersection of SW 20th Street and Crossland Lane, the Governing Body of Columbus, Kansas, directs the Public Works Department to place a permanent stop sign for Crossland Lane west bound traffic at said intersection.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
