ORDINANCE NO. 1415

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE FOR THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, CHAPTER I, ARTICLE 4, ESTABLISHING CHAPTER I, ARTICLE 4, SECTION 1-401A REGARDING FEES FOR INDIVIDUALS SERVING IN THE APPOINTED POSITIONS: MUNICIPAL JUDGE, CITY PROSECUTOR AND CITY ATTORNEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That Chapter I, Article 4, Section 1-401A shall be established in the Code for the City of Columbus, Kansas, to reflect the fees for appointed positions: Municipal Judge, City Prosecutor, and City Attorney, pursuant to the official City budget, effective January, 2018.

SECTION 2. NEW SECTION 1-401A: FEES - LEGAL SERVICES.

Beginning in January, 2018, pursuant to the City's approved 2018 budget, fees for contracted legal services provided by the individuals in the following appointed positions: Municipal Judge, City Prosecutor and City Attorney, shall be set at twelve hundred dollars (\$1200.00) per month, for each position.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
