

RESOLUTION NO. 117

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, on the 18th day of July, 1988, passed Ordinance No. 859 vacating that portion of Vermont Street hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance specifically provided that the Ordinance would become effective thirty (30) days after the publication of same in the official city newspaper unless one or more interested persons file a written protest before the expiration of such time; and

WHEREAS, written protest was filed with the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, on the 15th day of August, 1988; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the written notice of protest and Ordinance No. 859 the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, held a hearing to determine whether or not Ordinance No. 859 should be confirmed and ratified by the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, held the hearing on whether or not that portion of Vermont Street hereinafter described should be vacated on the 29th day of August, 1988; and


WHEREAS, at such hearing the Governing Body received testimony and evidence regarding the feasibility of the closure of said Vermont Street and by majority vote confirmed Ordinance No. 859.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Columbus, Kansas, does hereby confirm and ratify Ordinance No. 859 of the City of Columbus, Kansas, in its entirety and does ratify and confirm vacating that portion of Vermont Street described as follows, to-wit:


That portion of South Vermont Street bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest Corner (NW/C) of Block Five (5), in the First Addition to the Town (now City) of Columbus, according to the recorded plat of said Addition; thence South to the Southwest Corner (SW/C) of said Block Five (5); thence West Seventy (70) Feet; thence North to a point Seventy (70) Feet due West of the point of beginning; thence East Seventy (70) Feet to the point of beginning.

and that the vacation hereby ordered is done pursuant to the authority and provisions of K.S.A. 14-423 and the City Clerk of the City of Columbus, Kansas, shall file a certified copy of said Ordinance and a certified copy of this Resolution in the offices of the Register of Deeds and the County Clerk of Cheorkee County, Kansas, all as provided by K.S.A. 14-423.
