

RESOLUTION NO. 118

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO BENEFITS  
OBTAINABLE BY CITIES UNDER THE PROGRAM  
FOR FEDERAL AID ON HIGHWAY CONSTRUCTION

Be it Resolved by the Governing Body of the City of Columbus :

That the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized and directed to execute for and on behalf of the City of Columbus, Kansas, Agreement No. 40-88 between the City and the Kansas Department of Transportation, giving the Secretary of Transportation of the State of Kansas authority to act for the City, and in its place and stead, to obtain for the City such benefits as are obtainable under the program of the Federal Aid Plan of Highway Construction, and obtain the benefits of such legislation for the City on the terms and conditions set forth in such agreement as may be prepared and approved by the Secretary of Transportation for the improvement Construction of US-69 in the City of Columbus as follows: The entrance to
