A resolution requesting that an area in the City of Columbus be designated as an enterprise zone authorized by K.S.A. 12-17, 109 et. seq.

WHEREAS, the area bounded by Parcels 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8, are in the corporate limits of the City of Columbus; and

WHEREAS, the area of the proposed zone does not contain a swine confinement facility as defined by K.S.A. 17-5903 and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the area has a population of 171 persons which is 5.2% of the total 1990 city population; and

WHEREAS, the area of the zone is 210.41 acres which is 17.3% of the land area of the city and

WHEREAS, the areas are located wholly within a city which meets the requirements for federal assistance under section 119 of the Housing and Community development Act of 1974; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the eligibility requirements and certifies the correctness of supporting evidence; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Columbus does hereby rescind resolution # 101 dated June 1, 1987, contingent upon the approval of this application for amendment and reapproval by the Kansas Secretary of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the legal council for County Commission has provided a written opinion of conformance to the law for designation as an enterprise zone;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council or the City of Columbus; That the area defined herein meets the requirements for designation as an enterprise zone; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Kansas Secretary of Commerce is hereby requested to ammend and reapprove these designated areas as an authorized enterprise zone consistent with Kansas Statutes Annotated.
