A RESOLUTION ASSURING AND CERTIFYING TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE THAT THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, POSSESSES LEGAL AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION, TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE CITY C'ERK TO ACT AS THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GRANTEE.

- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus has the legal authority to apply for, receive and administer federal, state and other grants and loans through its Home Rule Power under Article 12-5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas and through Statute 12-1662, relative to expenditure of federal funds; and
- WHEREAS, The City is desirous of applying for a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funding through the Kansas Department of Commerce for the purpose of obtaining a Public Facilities Community Improvement Grant for Water Treatment Plant improvements and replacement of lead service lines as delineated in the CDBG application submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Governing Body does hereby authorize the Mayor and the City Clerk to act as the official representatives of the grantee and to sign and submit the application and final statement, and to provide such additional information as may be required and act as official representatives of the City in this and subsequent matters.
