RESOLUTION NO. 153

A RESOLUTION ASSURING THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE THAT FUNDS WILL BE CONTINUALLY PROVIDED FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATER SYSTEM TO BE FINANCED BY 1992 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, The City of Columbus, Kansas, is required by the Kansas Department of Commerce to submit a resolution of long-range financial support for the operation and maintenance of any project assisted with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the 1992 Small Cities CDBG Program application period; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Columbus is committed to providing water service to the residents of Columbus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: (1) The Governing Body assures the Kansas Department of Commerce that \$1,500.00 per month will be set aside for operation and maintenance of the water system and will be available for this purpose from committed, designated funds of the City, and primarily through rates paid by users which funds are sufficient to provide maintenance for both daily operation and contingencies; (2) All efforts shall be made to maintain water rates and provide for routine operation of the water system. These efforts are made to benefit the low-to-moderate income families and individuals in the City of Columbus; (3) Water rates shall be reviewed annually and adjusted if required to pay for proper operation and maintenance of the City's water utility.
