RESOLUTION NO. 154A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE CONTRIBUTION OF CITY FUNDS FOR THE
PURPOSE OF MAKING NEEDED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S
WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, The City of Columbus, Kansas, is applying for a Public Facilities Community Development Block Grant administered by the Kansas Department of Commerce; and


WHEREAS, The City of Columbus wishes to utilize this funding to make needed improvements to the City's Water Distribution System in the Community Development Block Grant application; and

WHEREAS, The City of Columbus will provide the amount of \$100,000 from the City's Water Fund for the purpose of making said Water Treatment Plant Improvements and the replacement of lead service lines contingent upon the approval of the Community Development Block Grant application for \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, The City of Columbus has received widespread and continued Community support for its efforts to obtain funding for the said Water Treatment Improvements and replacement of lead service lines.


