- A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE CONTRIBUTION OF CITY FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING NEEDED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S STORM WATER DRAINAGE
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus, Kansas, is applying for a Public Facilities Community Development Block Grant administered by the Kansas Department of Commerce; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus wishes to utilize this funding to make needed improvements to the City's Storm Water Drainage in the Community Development Block Grant Application; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus will provide the amount of \$83,000.00 in the form of in-kind services for the purpose of making said Storm Water Drainage Improvements contingent upon the approval of the Community Development Block Grant application for \$125,200.00; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus has received widespread and continued Community support for its efforts to obtain funding for the said Storm Water Drainage Improvements.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The City of Columbus, Kansas, hereby assures the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing that the City will provide \$83,000.00 from their Street Fund in the form of in-kind service, with employees being paid their normal rate of pay and the value of equipment usage established by common practice and rates utilized by the Kansas Department of Transportation in consultation with and approved by the Kansas Department of Commerce & Housing contingent upon the approval of the Community Development Block Grant application for \$125,200.00.
