RESOLUTION NUMBER 211

A RESOLUTION RECONFIRMING SUPPORT FOR THE QUALIFYING REGIONAL STRATEGIC PLAN AND REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF COMMERCE & HOUSING TO REAPPROVE THE COUNTY OF CHEROKEE AS A KANSAS ENTERPRISE ZONE DESIGNATED NON-METROPOLITAN REGION.

WHEREAS, a regional strategic plan, required by K. S. A. -----74-50-116 © (2), has been reviewed and updated; and

WHEREAS, the updated plan has been adopted by the City Council of the City of COLUMBUS, on February 3, 1997.

WHEREAS, a county-wide business incentive of county-wide job creation property tax abatement will be offered to all qualified businesses in the county; and

WHEREAS, an additional city-wide business incentive of a 3 month waiver of solid waste disposal in a approved county waste disposal site; and

WHEREAS, all expanding manufacturers in the City will be notified of the availability of the business incentives indicated above by a news release in the official County newspaper, and posting at City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of COLUMBUS chooses to continue to participate in the Kansas Enterprise Zone designated non-metropolitan region as provided for by K.S.A. 74-50-116;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF COLUMBUS THAT: THE SECRETARY OF COMMERCE & HOUSING IS HEREBY REQUESTED TO REAPPROVE THE COUNTY OF CHEROKEE AS A KANSAS ENTERPRISE ZONE DESIGNATED NON-METROPOLITAN REGION.
