A RESOLUTION ASSURING AND CERTIFYING TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND HOUSING THAT THE CITY OF COLUMBUS POSSESSES LEGAL AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION, TO RECEIVE GRANT FUNDS, AND HEREBY AUTHORIZES THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO ACT AS THE OFFICIAL REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GRANTEE.

- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus has the legal authority to apply for, receive and administer federal, state and other grants and loans through its Home Rule Power under Article 12-5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas and through Statute 12-1662, relative to expenditure of federal funds; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus is desirous of applying for U.S. Department of Commerce, Housing and Urban Development Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding through the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing for storm water drainage improvements as delineated in the Community Development Block Grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Governing Body of the City of Columbus does hereby authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to act as the official representatives of the grantee and to sign and submit the application and final statement, to provide such additional information as may be required, and act as official representatives of the City of Columbus in this and subsequent matters.
