## CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS

RESOLUTION NO. 220

A RESOLUTION ASSURING THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND HOUSING THAT FUNDS WILL BE CONTINUALLY PROVIDED FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE COLUMBUS STORM WATER DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS AS DELINEATED IN THE 1997 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION.

- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus is desirous of applying for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds under the Community Improvement/Public Facility category that are administered by the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus wishes to utilize this funding for the purpose of constructing storm water drainage improvements as delineated in the 1997 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant application, contingent upon Community Development Block Grant funding from the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing; and
- WHEREAS, Based on estimates provided by Mid-Kansas Engineering, Inc., the City of Columbus has determined that the annual cost of operation and maintenance of the proposed storm water drainage system improvements will be \$3,600.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Governing Body of the City of Columbus hereby assures the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing that it will annually allocate and reserve in a separate account the sum of \$3,600.00 for the continual operation and maintenance of the proposed storm water drainage system improvements as delineated in the 1997 Community Development Block Grant application, and that these costs will be reviewed annually, and that water charges will be adjusted, if necessary, to reflect and cover any increase in costs.
