## RESOLUTION NO. 237

A RESOLUTION ASSURING AND CERTIFYING TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND HOUSING THAT ALL NON-CDBG FUNDS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS ARE OBLIGATED ON A CONDITIONAL BASIS AS REQUIRED BY THE 1998 SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM.

- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus is desirous of applying for Community Development Block Grant funding from the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program administered by the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing; and
- WHEREAS, The City of Columbus wishes to utilize this funding to assist in the provision of the needed community improvements, as delineated in the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant application, contingent upon 1998 Community Development Block Grant funding from the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Governing Body of the City of Columbus hereby certifies to the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing that it will obligate \$ 42,500.00 of City funds, as the City's matching funds for all City projects included in the application that are delineated in the 1998 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant application, contingent upon approval of the Community Development Block Grant funding from the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: The Governing Body of the City of Columbus hereby certifies to the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing through inter local governmental agreements that all entities requesting funds will obligate \$ 150,846.20 of their respective funds, as the matching funds for all projects included in the application, that are not City related projects, delineated in the 1998 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant application, contingent upon approval of the Community Development Block Grant funding from the Kansas Department of Commerce and Housing.
