RESOLUTION NO. 257

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE QUALIFYING REGIONAL STRATEGIC PLAN AND REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF COMMERCE & HOUSING RE-APPROVE THE COUNTY OF CHEROKEE AS A KANSAS ENTERPRISE ZONE DESIGNATED NON-METROPOLITAN BUSINESS REGION.

WHEREAS, a regional strategic plan, required by K.S.A. 74-50, 116(c)(2), has been reviewed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Cherokee on April 19, 1999; and

WHEREAS, regional business incentives of free business finance counseling and a revolving loan business finance program provided by the Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission will be offered to all qualified businesses in the City; and

WHEREAS, a county-wide business incentive of county-wide job creation property tax abatement will be offered to all qualified businesses in the county; and

WHEREAS, an additional city-wide business incentive of three (3) month waiver of commercial or light industrial solid waste disposal (non-hazardous material) in an approved county waste disposal site can be offered to qualifying businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbus chooses to participate with and be included in the Southeast Kansas Regional Planning Commission designated non-metropolitan business region, as provided for by K.S.A. 74-50, 116; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbus pledges to promote the continued review and update of its qualifying regional strategic plan:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Columbus that the Secretary of Commerce & Housing is hereby requested to re-approve the County of Cherokee as a Kansas Enterprise Zone designated non-metropolitan business region pursuant to the Kansas Enterprise Zone Act.
