RESOLUTION NO. 289

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS REQUESTING A REVISION OF KDOT PROJECT 69-11 K-8009-01 AND COMMITING TO PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus, Kansas has submitted an application to the State of Kansas, Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) for a Geometric Improvement Highway project involving the improvement of Highway 69 from Maple Street south to the railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, KDOT approved the application to improve the highway corridor in January, 2000, at an appropriated level of \$925,000 with \$750,000 provided by the State for construction and \$175,000 from the City for preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and utilities relocation; and

WHEREAS, the project, designated as KDOT 69-11 K-8009-01, has been designed by Professional Engineering Consultants, P.A. under contract with the City of Columbus to include a middle turning lane, acceleration/deceleration lane by the Industrial Park, drainage improvements to protect the roadway, replacement of deteriorating road surface and widening and signalization of the Maple Street & East Avenue intersection; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary cost estimate has been determined to be \$1,325,960.00 which is over the approved project amount; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas feels the project design addresses a multitude of safety issues, property protection issues and roadway protection issues of the busy roadway corridor and chooses not to sacrifice or delete designed project features.

- **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Columbus, Kansas, the following:
- Section 1. The City Council requests to the KDOT a revision of the project scope of KDOT 69-11 K-8009-01 to include the safety and protection features of the project as designed by Professional Engineering Consultants, P.A. at a cost estimate of \$1,325,960.00; and
- Section 2. The City Council affirms its approval to move the project back one year in the KDOT's schedule of roadway projects from Year 2003 to Year 2004; and
- Section 3. The City Council reaffirms its commitment to provide funding for preliminary engineering costs, right-of-way acquisition and utilities relocation associated with the project; and

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Council, through adoption of this resolution, expresses its commitment to provide an additional \$77,000.00 to project construction thereby making the total City contribution for project construction of \$175,000.
