RESOLUTION NO. 374

A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AT WHICH THE OWNERS, HIS OR HER AGENT, LIENHOLDERS OF RECORD, OCCUPANTS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST OF STRUCTURES LOCATED WITHIN SAID CITY AND DESCRIBED HEREIN, MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH STRUCTURES SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED AS UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS STRUCTURES.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 21st day of April, 2008, file with the Governing Body of said City, a statement in writing that the structures, hereinafter described, are unsafe and dangerous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

That a hearing was held on the 7th day of July, 2008, before the Governing Body of the City at 7:45 o'clock p.m., at Columbus City Hall Council Chambers, 300 East Maple, Columbus, Kansas 66725, at which an owner, David Touchton, appeared and stated that he would demolish the structure on his property identified as unsafe and/or dangerous, located at:

401 N. Ohio Avenue, Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, consisting of Block 2 in Park Addition, described as:

LOT 11

This matter shall be reviewed on Tuesday, September 2, 2008, at 6:30 p.m., for the completion of the demolition and removal of debris

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published and shall give notice of the aforesaid hearing in the manner provided by law.
