

**MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN RESOLUTION**

**RESOLUTION NO. 389**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, STATING THAT IT IS THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO APPROVE AND ADOPT THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL NATURAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN INCLUDING ALL STATE AND FEMA REQUIREMENTS IN COMPLIANCE WITH FEMA STANDARDS AND GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, Cherokee County, Kansas has contracted with Brake & Associates, LLC to gather information and prepare a Multi-Jurisdictional Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cherokee County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been prepared in compliance with State and FEMA requirements, including the standards and guidelines as set forth by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Columbus, Kansas, further affirm that this Plan shall be reviewed and updated as appropriate per FEMA guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Columbus Kansas, that the City affirms its commitment to the Cherokee County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as appropriate for the citizens of the City of Columbus, Kansas, and reaffirms the adoption by the rules and regulations established herein.
