RESOLUTION NO. 404

A RESOLUTION DISMISSING THE CONDEMNATION ACTION CONCERNING THE STRUCTURE(S) LOCATED AT 712 E. WALNUT, COLUMBUS, CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS, CONSISTING OF BLOCK 13 IN P O 1 (Park Addition) SUBDIVISION, DESCRIBED AS: LOT 4

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 19th day of October, 2009, file with the Governing Body of said City, a statement in writing that the structures, hereinafter described, are unsafe and dangerous.

The following parties in interest appeared: David Tillman and Rebecca Tillman.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, THAT:

1. The Governing Body hereby finds that the owners of the structures located at Block 13 in P O 1 (Park Addition) Subdivision, Lot 4, in the City of Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, and commonly known and referred to as 712 E. Walnut, Columbus, Kansas, have repaired the structure(s) sufficiently, and that the condemnation should be dismissed herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the condemnation action is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
