

RESOLUTION NO. 508

A RESOLUTION BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REVISING TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAGE AT DESIGNATED INTERSECTIONS IN THE INTEREST OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, is revising the system of traffic control signage at designated intersections with numerous historical automobile accidents.

WHEREAS, yield signs shall be removed, and permanent stop signs shall be installed at the intersection of South Pennsylvania Avenue and West Mulberry Street for north and south bound traffic.

WHEREAS, yield signs shall be removed, and permanent stop signs shall be installed at the intersection of South Pennsylvania Avenue and West Olive Street for north and south bound traffic.

WHEREAS, yield signs shall be removed, and permanent stop signs shall be installed at the intersection of South Minnesota Avenue and West Olive Street for east and west bound traffic.

WHEREAS, yield signs shall be removed, and permanent stop signs shall be installed at the intersection of South Minnesota Avenue and West Mulberry Street for east and west bound traffic.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, adopts the revised system of traffic control at designated intersections.
