

RESOLUTION NO. 517

**A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AT WHICH THE OWNERS, HIS OR HER AGENT, LIENHOLDERS OF RECORD, OCCUPANTS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST OF A STRUCTURE LOCATED WITHIN SAID CITY AND DESCRIBED HEREIN, MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS STRUCTURE AND DEBRIS SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED.**

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017, file with the Governing Body of said City, a statement in writing that the brown, two-story garage and miscellaneous debris inside the garage, described herein, are unsafe and dangerous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

That a hearing will be held on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 2017, before the Governing Body of the City at 6:45 p.m., at Columbus City Hall Council Chambers, 300 East Maple, Columbus, Kansas 66725, at which the owner, his or her agent, any lienholders of record, any occupant and any other parties in interest, as that term is defined by law, of the brown garage structure and miscellaneous debris located on the northwest edge of the property at:

515 West Olive Street, Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, described as:  
parcel number 011-136-13-0-30-20-015.00-0, Deems Addition to City of Columbus,  
Kansas, Block 1, Lots 20 and 21,

may appear and show cause why said garage and debris should not be condemned as an unsafe or dangerous structure and debris and ordered repaired or demolished and the debris removed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published and shall give notice of the aforesaid hearing in the manner provided by law.
