

RESOLUTION NO. 518

A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AT WHICH THE OWNERS, HIS OR HER AGENT, LIENHOLDERS OF RECORD, OCCUPANTS AND OTHER PARTIES IN INTEREST OF STRUCTURES AND RECREATIONAL TRAILER LOCATED WITHIN SAID CITY AND DESCRIBED HEREIN, MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH UNSAFE AND DANGEROUS STRUCTURES, TRAILER AND DEBRIS SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer of the City of Columbus, Kansas, did on the 5th day of September, 2017, file with the Governing Body of said City, a statement in writing that the partially torn-down garage, the additional garage structure, the dilapidated Nomad trailer and miscellaneous debris inside and surrounding the structures, described herein, are unsafe and dangerous.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

That a hearing will be held on the 6th day of November 2017, before the Governing Body of the City at 6:45 p.m., at Columbus City Hall Council Chambers, 300 East Maple, Columbus, Kansas 66725, at which the owner, his or her agent, any lienholders of record, any occupant and any other parties in interest, as that term is defined by law, of the garage structures, trailer and miscellaneous debris located close to the alley on the property at:

203 S. Idaho Avenue, Columbus, Cherokee County, Kansas, described as:
parcel number 011-136-14-0-40-06-007.00-0, High School Addition to City of Columbus, Kansas, Block 7, Lot 3,

may appear and show cause why said garage, trailer and debris should not be condemned as an unsafe or dangerous structure and debris and ordered repaired or demolished and the debris removed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published and shall give notice of the aforesaid hearing in the manner provided by law.
