Patrol Officer



City Pool

The Pool is now open and operating hours are Wednesday thru Sunday from 2:00 –7:00 p.m. A limit of 50 people in the pool and 20 outside the pool at a time will be enforced. In order to accommodate this limit, we will be taking patrons in time slots. The first slot is from 2-4 and the second slot is from 4:30-7:00 allowing for a break for sanitizing. Reservations are not required and no re-entry is allowed when your session ends. At this time we will not offer season passes, pool parties, aerobics, swim lessons or schools/day cares. Water fountains and changing rooms are closed and we ask that you enter and exit in your swimsuit to avoid lines in the restroom. Admission to the pool is \$2 for ages 5 & Under and \$3 for ages 6 & Up. **We are excited to announce admission will be free on July 4.**
