ORDINANCE NO. 1417

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAGE FOR THE NORTH - SOUTH ALLEY CONNECTING EAST MAPLE STREET AND EAST PINE STREET IN THE 100 BLOCK OF SAID STREETS IN COLUMBUS, KANSAS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:**

**SECTION 1.** Due to wide commercial traffic, narrow passage and safety concerns at the north end of the alley connecting East Pine Street and East Maple Street in the 100 block, the Governing Body of the City of Columbus, Kansas, directs the Public Works Department to place permanent one-way signage requiring all traffic to enter the alley from the south and prohibiting entrance from the north.


**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
