ORDINANCE NO. 1422

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1421, AND VACATING THE FOLLOWING "L" SHAPED ALLEYS PURSUANT TO THE CORRECT REVISED LEGAL DESCRIPTION LOCATED IN REESE'S ADDITION AND THE THIRD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, CHEROKEE COUNTY, KANSAS:

THE EAST-WEST ALLEY IN REESE'S ADDITION BEGINNING AT VERMONT AVENUE, BORDERING LOTS 4, 5, AND 6 ON THE NORTH, AND BORDERING LOT 3 ON THE SOUTH; AND THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY BORDERING LOTS 1, 2, AND 3 ON THE EAST IN REESE'S ADDITION AND BORDERING LOT 5 ON THE WEST IN THE THIRD ADDITION, ALL SUBJECT TO UTILITY EASEMENTS RETAINED BY THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the East-West Alley in Reese's Addition to the City of Columbus, Kansas, beginning at Vermont Avenue, thence East, bordering lots 4, 5, and 6 on the North, and bordering lot 3 on the South, approximately twenty (20) feet wide and one hundred seventy-five (175) feet long, SHALL BE VACATED, SUBJECT TO UTILITY EASEMENTS.

SECTION 2: That the North-South Alley in Reese's Addition and in the Third Addition to the City of Columbus, Kansas, bordering lots 1, 2, and 3 on the East in Reese's Addition and bordering lot 5 on the West in the Third Addition, approximately twenty (20) feet wide and one hundred fifty-seven and three tenths (157.3) feet long to the boundary of the Frisco Right-of-Way, SHALL BE VACATED, SUBJECT TO UTILITY EASEMENTS.

SECTION 3: That the aforementioned alleys shall revert to the owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to the frontage of such real estate except in cases where said alley was taken and appropriated to public use in a different proportion, in which case it shall revert to adjacent lots of real estate in proportion as it was taken from them.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 6: Immediately after this Ordinance becomes effective, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the County Clerk and in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Cherokee County, Kansas, to be entered in the transfer records and in the deed records, respectively, of Cherokee County, Kansas.
