ORDINANCE NO. 1423

AN ORDINANCE BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, AMENDING THE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, TO REPLACE THE WAGE RANGE CHART, APPENDIX A, AND ADOPT THE REVISED WAGE RANGE CHART, APPENDIX A.

WHEREAS, the Personnel Regulations for the City of Columbus, Kansas, comprised of Article I through Article XVII and the Wage Range Chart, Appendix A, were adopted by the City to establish rules and regulations for the administration of the pay plan for personnel.

WHEREAS, the Wage Range Chart, Appendix A, adopted through Ordinance No. 1416 on February 20, 2018, shall be repealed and replaced by the revised pay plan identified as the Wage Range Chart, Appendix A, dated 07/02/2018.

WHEREAS, each job description heading shall be updated to reflect the corresponding wage range and classification from the Wage Range Chart.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: The Wage Range Chart, Appendix A, dated 01/16/2018, and all related Ordinances shall be repealed.

SECTION 2: The Personnel Regulations for the City of Columbus, Kansas shall be amended to establish a revised pay plan referred to as the Wage Range Chart, Appendix A, dated 07/02/2018.


SECTION 3: The employees holding the following positions shall be subject to scheduled performance evaluations but are not eligible for merit wage increases in 2018 due to the pay adjustments reflected in the Wage Range Chart, Appendix A, dated 07/02/2018: Backup Fire Relief Driver; Fire Relief Driver; Fire Driver; and Fire Lead Driver.

SECTION 4: The heading of each job description shall be updated to reflect the corresponding Wage Range and Classification from the revised Wage Range Chart, Appendix A.

SECTION 5: All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.


SECTION 6: This ordinance shall be published in the official City newspaper.
