ORDINANCE NO. 1428

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS, VACATING THE EAST-WEST ALLEY, LOCATED IN LISLE'S 1ST ADDITION, BLOCK 8, SOUTH OF EAST OAK STREET, NORTH OF EAST SYCAMORE STREET, EAST OF NORTH 2ND AVENUE AND WEST OF NORTH 3RD AVENUE, BORDERING ON THE SOUTH OF LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 AND 6, AND BORDERING ON THE NORTH OF LOTS 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 AND 12; MEASURING APPROXIMATELY TWENTY FEET (20') WIDE AND TWO HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT FEET (288') LONG, SUBJECT TO THE CITY PERMANENTLY RETAINING ALL UTILITY EASEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, KANSAS.

Section 1: The East-West Alley, Located In Columbus, Lisle's 1st Addition, Block 8, South Of East Oak Street, North Of East Sycamore Street, East Of North 2nd Avenue And West Of North 3rd Avenue, Bordering On The South Of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 And 6, And Bordering On The North Of Lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 And 12; Measuring Approximately Twenty Feet (20') Wide And Two Hundred Eighty-Eight Feet (288') Long, SHALL BE VACATED, SUBJECT TO THE CITY PERMANENTLY RETAINING ALL UTILITY EASEMENTS.

Section 2: That the aforementioned alley shall revert to the owners of real estate thereto adjacent on each side, in proportion to the frontage of such real estate except in cases where said alley was taken and appropriated to public or private use in a different proportion, in which case it shall revert to adjacent lots of real estate in proportion as it was taken from them.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon passage and shall be published in the official city newspaper.



Immediately after this Ordinance becomes effective, the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this Ordinance in the Office of the County Clerk and in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Cherokee County, Kansas, to be entered in the transfer records and in the deed records, respectively, of Cherokee County, Kansas.
